Relative to recognizing and memorializing the late Honorable Juan Crisostomo Cruz, former Mayor of Inarajan, and to extending sincere condolences to his family, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam.

BE IT RESOLVED BY *I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Juan Crisostomo Cruz was born on September 22, 1933 to the late Maria Crisostomo Cruz and late Felix Duenas Cruz, and he was called to his eternal reward on Monday, June 7, 2011, at the age of seventy-eight (78) years; and

WHEREAS, the late Juan Crisostomo Cruz married the former Maria Leon Guerrero Quinata, his soul mate, and from that union, Juan and Maria became the proud parents of eight (8) children, thirteen (13) grandchildren and ten (10) great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, the late Juan Crisostomo Cruz retired from the Office Services Division, Officer in Charge of Construction, Marianas as an Administrative Services

2 Fundamentals of Supervision, Basic Supervisory, Equal Employment Opportunity

5 Assistance, Program Seminar on Basic Creative Problem; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the late Juan Crisostomo Cruz, devoted his time to his community
7 which involved serving as Scout Master, Troop 27, *Inarajan*; Member, Parish
8 Council, *Inarajan*; Served as the Treasure for the *Inarajan* Civic Improvement; He
9 managed the Saint Joseph Basketball Team; was the Chairman for the Christmas Fund
10 Rasing for *Inarajan* Elementary School; and volunteered his services to the Saint
11 Joseph Church in his beloved community; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the late Juan Crisostomo Cruz loved the land and worked
13 tirelessly on the farm and from his hard work, he would share his crops relatives,
14 friends and neighbors;

15 **WHEREAS**, the late Juan Crisostomo Cruz was the last commissioner of
16 *Inarajan* to be denoted the title of commissioner and the first to be denoted as the
17 Mayor of *Inarajan*; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the late Juan Crisostomo Cruz, during his tenure as commissioner
19 and mayor, he administered numerous projects and programs that have socially,
20 economically, and politically benefited the people of *Inarajan*.; and

21 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby,
22 on behalf of the people of Guam, recognizing and memorializing the late Honorable
23 Juan Crisostomo Cruz, former Mayor of Inarajan, and to extending sincere
24 condolences to his family, on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guahan and the people of
25 Guam.; and be it further
