- 3 WHEREAS, the official purpose of "Parks and Recreation Month" is to invite
- 4 participation in quality activities by the community; and
- 5 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Parks and Recreation performs a wide variety of
- 6 park, recreation and historic preservation services for our community; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation is committed to improving
- 8 the quality of life for our community and for our visitors, by promoting healthy
- 9 lifestyles, strengthening our families, maintaining our parks and natural areas, and
- 10 preserving our island's unique heritage; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation continues to properly maintain and operate parks and recreational facilities; to seek funding to ensure that all Parks, equipment and facilities are safe, attractive, accessible and user-friendly; and to ensure that our island's historic sites are protected and restored for the benefit of present and future generations; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation provides activities that can reduce stress, provide socialization opportunities, and improve the mental and physical well-being of our youth, adults, seniors and challenged individuals; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation, recognizes the importance of our rich heritage through the preservation of our many historic sites, and acknowledging Guam's Pre-Contact, Spanish, Early American, Japanese/World War II and Post War Historic Timelines; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks and Recreation is mandated by law to be responsible for 76 active parks; over 4,794 acres of seashore, conservation and wildlife refuge, is responsible to protect and maintain over 1600 historic sites in its inventory, reviews over 1100 building permits annually to ensure that historic sites are taken into consideration; processes over 1400 park permits; 20+ vendor permits, 150+ facility permits so that island residents can enjoy the outdoor environment such as beaches and parks; and

WHEREAS, I Liheslaturan Guåhan recognizes the contributions of partners in the community that steadfastly support the Department of Parks and Recreation and have contributed to the preservation, protection and interpretation of Guam's historic and cultural resources as well as the beautification and maintenance of our parks and recreational facilities; and
