3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. George Chiu, a well-known and successful Guam
4 businessman, and Executive Vice President of Tan Holdings Corporation, a
5 position he has held since 1992, is one of our island's most community-
6 minded individuals; and

7 **WHEREAS**, In addition to managing Tan Holdings throughout
8 Micronesia, Mr. Chiu also wears a number of other hats, including Vice
9 President and Director of Consolidated Transportation Services, Inc. (CTSI);

11 Guam Chinese Association; Board Member of the Guam Economic
12 Development Authority; Treasurer and member of the Board of Directors of

3 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Chiu was born on August 25, 1961, in Okinawa,
4 Japan, and eventually made his way to Guam, where he graduated from
5 John F. Kennedy High School and in 1985 began attending the University of
6 Guam, receiving a Bachelor's Degree in Management and Accounting in
7 1988, and he is a Certified Public Accountant; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Chiu has always been an active participant in island
9 business matters, as well as in a number of civic and other community
10 organizations; his involvement including: President of Luen Thai Fishing
11 Venture, Ltd.; President of Cosmos Distributing Co. Ltd. in Guam and
12 Saipan; President of Dickerson & Quinn Company, Ltd.; and was a member
13 of the Guam Buildup and Economic Development Committee of the
14 governor's transition team; and

15 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Chiu has devoted much of his life, knowledge and
16 acumen toward growing and advancing the economy of Guam; now,
17 therefore, be it
