WHEREAS, Antonio attended the prestigious Sergeant Major Academy in El Paso, Texas in 1985 and was elected Vice-President of Class "25" and retired in 1993 with the rank of Command Sergeant Major (E9) after devoting 30 years of his life proudly defending our nation; and
