WHEREAS, Yvonne was promoted to Clerk I on December 12, 1979 and seven months later to Clerk Typist II; She then laterally transferred to the Division of Public Welfare Assistance Payment Section (now Bureau of Economic Security); and

WHEREAS, Yvonne was promoted to Assistance Payment Worker I on May 30, 1984 and one year later to Assistance Payment Worker II (later reclassified to Eligibility Specialist II on October 1, 1988); Her job was to determine the eligibility of individuals and their families for public welfare benefits; and

WHEREAS, Yvonne transferred to the Bureau of Management Support on August 27, 1990 when she was promoted to Social Services Field Representative II, where she investigated allegations of fraud and abuse of the Food Stamp and Public Welfare Assistance Programs; Her position was later reclassified to Public Welfare Investigator II on October I, 1990; a position she held until her retirement; and

WHEREAS, Yvonne was an active member of the DPHSS Employee Association and served as president from 2007 until her retirement; under her leadership, the Employee Association had a record number of employees sign up for membership and is credited for holding successful fundraising activities including basket raffles and

lunch plates which paid for Christmas parties, lunches, door prizes, t-shirts, umbrellas, gas coupons, movie tickets, and birthday cakes for the members; and
