WHEREAS, Consul Kerwin Orville Casano Tate is the second son of the late Atty. Orville Federis Tate and Mrs. Teresita Casano Tate. He assumed his duty as Consul at the Philippine Consulate General on 25 September 2004 ;
and

WHEREAS, Consul Tate, who hails from Naga City, is married to Issa De La Cruz, also from Naga City. They have a son, Julian Rasheed; and

WHEREAS, he got his elementary education from the Naga Parochial School in 1986 and graduated high school from the Holy Rosary Minor Seminary in 1990; and

WHEREAS, Consul Tate is an AB English (Literature) graduate from the Ateneo de Naga University in 1995, where he was a Dean's Lister. He studied

1 law at the University of the Philippines from 1995-1998, and earned his
2 Bachelor of Laws from the Far Eastern University in 2002; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Consul Tate is also a career officer in the Department of
4 Foreign Affairs (DFA) with the rank of Foreign Service Officer (FSO) I. He
5 joined the DFA in 2000 after passing the highly competitive Foreign Service
6 Officers examination in 1999; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Consul Tate served as the Acting Director of the Property,
8 Engineering and Transportation Division of the Office of Personnel and
9 Administrative Services from 2001-2002; and

10 **WHEREAS**, He also served as Principal Assistant at the Office of Asian
11 and Pacific Affairs' Southeast Asia Division from 2002-2003, and at the Office
12 of American Affairs in 2002; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Prior to his posting here in Guam, Consul Tate was Acting
14 Director of the Authentication Division of the DFA's Office of Consular
15 Affairs from 2003-2004; and

16 **WHEREAS**, He is also a member of *Kabulig*, the Bicolano writers' group
17 of the Philippine National Center for Culture and the Arts, was Editor-in-
18 Chief of *the Pillars*, the Ateneo De Naga University newspaper, and Captain of
19 the Ateneo University Debate Team; and

20 **WHEREAS**, Consul Tate was one of the youngest-ever editors of a Bikol
21 newspaper, when he became the editor-in-chief of the "Iyo Ni" newsweekly at
22 the age of 21; and now, therefore be it

1 **RESOLVED**, that I *Mina' Trentai Unu na Liheslaturan Guåhan*, does
2 hereby, on behalf of the People of Guam, recognize and congratulate Consul
3 Kerwin Orville Casano Tate by wishing him well on his new journey and

5 contributions, and does further extend *Un Dangkulo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase* to him
6 for his many years of service and dedication to the People of Guam; and be it
