- 10 WHEREAS, in 1983, she moved to Pittsburgh, PA to work as surgical
- 11 intensive care nurse at Allegheny General Hospital, started as research nurse

- 3 WHEREAS, from 1997 to 2002, Dr. Kramer was the program coordinator
- 4 for Diabetes Prevention Program (DPP) of the University of Pittsburgh, PA
- 5 then became the research associate of the Department of Epidemiology,

- 7 2002; and
