RELATIVE TO COMMENDING THE PRINCIPAL, TEACHER AND STUDENTS OF KANAGAWA PREFECTURE, KANAGAWA KENRITSU OOHARA HIGH SCHOOL, JAPAN FOR THEIR VISIT TO GUAM TO PAY RESPECT TO THE VICTIMS OF WORLD WAR II IN GUAM, AND TO PROMOTE PEACE AND FELLOWSHIP THROUGH THEIR VISIT TO GUAM, AND TO THANK MR. KENSUKE HAGA AND THE U.S. EXPLORE AND STUDY INC., FOR THEIR WORK ON THE PROJECT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI UNO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, a group of one hundred sixty five (165) high school students and their
 advisers from Japan visited Guam for the purpose of showing respect and prayer for those
 who died during World War II ; and

WHEREAS, those students visited the War in the Pacific National Park, Gaan Point,
Faha Massacre site and Manenggon Memorial Park in order to better understand the
horrors of war and its effects on both the innocent civilians caught in its wake and the
soldiers who fought it; and

- 8 **WHEREAS,** it is hoped that this will continue to be an annual trip, and that the 9 tribute paid by thee students will shine as an example that will encourage other students 10 and organizations from Japan to make similar trips; and
- WHEREAS, the U.S. Explore and Study, Inc., has been instrumental in trying to heal
 the wounds of World War II and tensions over the war between the people of Guam, Japan

and the United States, and has held ceremonies and tributes in past years with that noble
 aim; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Explore an Study, Inc., along with its president, Mr. Kensuke Haga,
have worked extremely hard to move towards these goals and especially to help organize
this trip by Japanese high students; now, therefore, be it
