- WHEREAS, the late Jeff David T. Barcinas was born on January 18,
- 2 1956 as one (1) of five (5) to the late Jose Cruz Barcinas and the late Rita
- 3 Tajalle Tainatongo of Malesso; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was baptized in February of 1956 at San Dimas
- 5 Catholic Church in Malesso, received his First Holy Communion from Mt.
- 6 Carmel Catholic Church in Agat and was confirmed at San Dimas Catholic
- 7 Church in Malesso on March 13, 1964 by Bishop Apollinaris Baumgartner,
- 8 OFMcap. D.D.; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff received his education from different
- 10 schools around the island. He attended Inarajan Elementary School for
- 11 kindergarten and Mt. Carmel Catholic School for elementary school and
- later attended Father Duenas Memorial School where he graduated from in
- 13 1974; and

WHEREAS, he attended the University of Guam from 1974 to 1976, then transferred to California State Polytechnic University in Pomona, California and graduated in June 1979 with a Bachelor of Science Degree with an emphasis in agricultural economics and crop production; and

WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff then received a Master of Arts Degree from Washington State University in 1981 with emphasis in farm management and agricultural development. His master's project was Small Farm Record Book System that was eventually published as a Cooperative Extension Manual; and

WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff became a doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) at the Ohio State University in 1989 with an emphasis in extension education, research and statistics, administration in higher education, and evaluation; and

WHEREAS, he began working at the University of Guam in 1979 as an extension agent of the College of Agriculture and Life Science, teaching different agriculture courses and providing information and informal educational programs to farmers and residents of Guam. He then served in various roles at the university; and

WHEREAS, from 1992-1995 Deacon Jeff served as the associate dean of the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences from where he assisted in the management of the Cooperative Extension Service programs and where he was directly responsible for the core programs, budget, organizational structure, and personnel. Later he became the dean and director of the college until 2003 where he provided leadership, direction and supervision over the academic programs, research activities and outreach functions; and

WHEREAS, he also served as the Acting Academic Vice-President 41 in 2000 and the Acting Associate Vice-President of Enrollment Management 42 and Student Services from 2002 to 2003; and 43 WHEREAS, he became the Vice-President of University and 44 Community Engagement and the Director of Cooperative Extension Service 45 in 2003 and retired from these positions in December of 2008. In these 46 positions he established the new initiative of the engagement program of the 47 University of Guam and focused on strengthening local and federal relations 48 and partnering with nation and regional organizations to increase revenue 49 opportunities for the University of Guam; and 50 51 WHEREAS, Deacon Jeff was the personal secretary to Metropolitan Archbishop of Agana, Most Rev. Anthony Sablan Apuron, OFMcap.D.D. He 52 was also the Archdiocese of Agana Spokesperson; and 53 WHEREAS, his pastoral experiences include: Liturgical Commission 54 Liturgical for Guidelines for **Technical** Writer Baptism, RCIA. 55 Confirmation, Matrimony (1999-2001), Deacon Assistant, Parishes of San 56 Dimas and San Dionisio (August 16, 2003 to Present), and Archdiocese of 57 Agana Sexual Abuse Response Coordinator (March 2010 to Present); and 58 WHEREAS, he was a recipient of several awards such as Director 59 Emeritus- Western Association of Cooperation Extension Directors (March 60 2008), NASULGC Plague of Recognition for Service as member of the 61 Extension Committee on Organization and Policy (November 2007), Top 62 Ten Donor, University of Guam Endowment Foundation (2007), Lifetime 63 64 Donor, University of Guam Endowment Foundation (2002), Nominated and Selected International Distinguished Scientific Leader (2002), Nominated 65 and Selected Outstanding Young Man of America (1981 and 1989), 66 Inducted in Chi Omicron Gamma Honorary Fraternity, UOG (1990), 67 Inducted into Gamma Sigma Delta, Agricultural Honorary Fraternity in 68

- Ohio State University Beta Chapter 1988 and nominated for Who/Who's in Guam in Twentieth Century (1990); and
