- WHEREAS, the Under-16, Under-19, as well as the men's and women's teams

- 3 Cup qualifying events; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the tournaments have allowed GFA teams to have competed in
- 5 numerous tournaments off island to include the Philippines, Japan, Korea, Vietnam,
- 6 China, Nepal, Tahiti, Papua New Guinea, Vanuatu, Fiji, and Palau; and
- WHEREAS, these events wouldn't be possible with out the continued support
- 8 and assistance from FIFA and the AFC;
- 9 WHEREAS, FIFA awards organizations such as GFA with Goal Program
- projects slated to assist in the pursuit of the promotion and advancement of Football
- on Guam; and
- WHEREAS, in 2003 the first FIFA Goal Program project was awarded for the
- Guam Football Association Headquarters Building I providing for the partial
- installment of lights for the lower and upper fields, a total investment of over
- 15 \$500,000; and
- WHEREAS, in 2006 the second installment of the FIFA Goal Program project
- was awarded for the Guam Football Association Headquarters Building II for a
- parking lot, futsal field, and to complete the lighting for the upper field, a total
- investment of over \$1,200,000; and
- 20 WHEREAS, in 2010 the third installment of the FIFA Goal Program project
- 21 was awarded for the regulation sized Football Turf pitch, a total investment of over
- 22 \$800,000; and
- WHEREAS, in 2011 the fourth FIFA Goal Program project was awarded for
- 24 the Football Turf mini pitches, a total investment of over \$500,000; and
