1       **WHEREAS**, Ms. Lourdes "Queen Lulubelle" V. Bautista was born on February  
2       10, 1963 to Mr. †Peter and Pilar Bautista; Ms. Bautista and her family are from the  
3       beautiful village of Barrigada; and

4       **WHEREAS**, Ms. Bautista began her government service with the Guam  
5       Community College on June 14, 1982, where she worked as a Clerk Typist III; she later  
6       served as a Word Processing Secretary II beginning August 20, 1986 until November 7,  
7       1988, when she became an Administrative Secretary II, the position from which she  
8       now retires; and

9           **WHEREAS**, during her time employed with the Guam Community College, Ms.  
10   Bautista has displayed exemplary service not only to the students, staff and faculty, but  
11   to the Board of Trustees and the Foundation Board of Governors as well; and

12           **WHEREAS**, she has set a good example of someone with a “Can Do” attitude  
13   and who works as a “Team Player” and she will be truly missed; and

14           **WHEREAS**, in addition to her service to our government, Ms. Bautista has also  
15   dedicated her time to serve the Santa Teresita Church Parish community in Mangilao,  
16   where she has served very active roles, including 2000-2008 Secretary, Parish Social  
17   Committee; 2003-2009 Chairperson, New Church, Same Spirit Coin Drive Program; and  
18   2009-Present Member, Parish Social Committee; and

19           **WHEREAS**, Ms. Bautista also displays the same dedication in her personal life as  
20   her professional life, through her help as the family’s Chief Information Officer, serving  
21   as a central communications hub for over 500 individuals, sharing information such as  
22   births, deaths, celebrations, calls for prayers, and family gatherings, among other
