Leon Guerrero Middle School, Benavente Middle School, 22 Tamuning Elementary School, Price Elementary School, Agueda Johnston Middle School, 23 Carbullido Elementary School, and Jose Rios Middle School; and WHEREAS, Big Brothers Big Sisters Guam partners with schools, faith-based 24 25 institutions, businesses, government agencies, and other non-profit organizations to carry out 26 its mission of serving youth; and 27 WHEREAS, the volunteers of Big Brothers Big Sisters Guam come from all walks of 28 life and range from high-school students to active seniors; and
