3        **WHEREAS**, the late **Jane Hainline Hammons Underwood**, professor  
4 emerita of anthropology at University of Arizona, is survived by two children,  
5 Anne and Michelle, and a grandson Sean, and was pre-deceased by her daughter  
6 Susan; and

7        **WHEREAS**, the late Jane, who was born in Fort Bliss, TX to a Quaker  
8 army family, married at 15, and balanced the rigors of an undergraduate education  
9 with raising children in order to graduate from University of California Riverside  
10 with a degree in anthropology and biology in 1960.

11        **WHEREAS**, the late Jane chose a career in anthropology as a reaction to  
12 her post-war experiences in Germany and her struggle to understand people's  
13 capacity for inhumanity; and

14        **WHEREAS**, the late Jane completed a PhD at the University of California  
15 Los Angeles (UCLA) in 1964, graduating as one of the few women biological  
16 anthropologists at the time; and
