- 4 arrived in Guam on April 9, 2010 and will be returning to Japan March 19,

- 6 WHEREAS, Consul-General Kimura provided distinguished service in
- 7 the course of his tenure to both the government of Japan and the government
- 8 of Guam and the people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, our people of Guam, our Governor, Legislators and 1 2 representatives of the United States military stationed in Guam will long remember that Consul-General Kimura became the first citizen of his country 3 to be privileged to tour the Naval Magazine site, a highly restricted military 4 5 reservation; and 6 WHEREAS, we will also recall forever the moving tributes that Consul-General Kimura paid on behalf of his country to the victims of the World War 7 8 II massacres at the Fena, Merizo, Yigo, and Mannengon sites, both to those who 9 perished at the hands of Japanese troops and their descendants; and WHEREAS, Consul-General Kimura served his country in Guam during 10 the time of its great peril due to the tragic Great East Japan Earthquake 11 12 Disaster; and WHEREAS, Consul-General Kimura played a notable role 13 coordinating relief efforts to Japan including that of 'Operation Tomodachi,' 14 based in part in Guam, which provided extensive rescue, relief work and 15 16 recovery support to that beleaguered nation; and 17 WHEREAS, even though Consul-General Kimura will now move on with his career by returning to Japan, his accomplishments and relationships 18 developed in Guam will keep him in our hearts forever; now, therefore, be it 19 20 RESOLVED, that I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan, does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend the 21
