RELATIVE TO COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE BANK OF GUAM, AND THE LEON GUERRERO FAMILY, ON THE OCCASION OF THE FORTIETH (40<sup>TH</sup>) ANNIVERSARY OF ONE OF GUAM'S MOST ICONIC INSTITUTIONS; AND TO FURTHER EXPRESSING A MOST SINCERE *UN DANGKOLO NA SI YU'OS MA'ASE'* FOR THE BANK'S CONTINUED CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE GROWTH AND PROGRESS OF OUR ISLAND AND PEOPLE.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN:

WHEREAS, the Bank of Guam, also known as "Bankon Ifit," officially chartered on March 13, 1972, will celebrate its Fortieth (40th) Anniversary, and 40 years of service to the western Pacific region on March 13, 2012; and

6 WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" was chartered by its founder and former

Chairman of the Board, the late Jesus S. Leon Guerrero, on March 13, 1972, with

8 One Million Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500,000) in equity; success for the

institution came quickly, with the business reaching profitability within a mere

six (6) weeks; and built their first three (3) storey headquarters in 1975, now the

site of the Santa Cruz branch; and

WHEREAS, the young, growing institution came to the aid of the

community after Guam was struck by Super Typhoon Pamela in April, 1976,

with "Bankon Ifit" distributing food stamps to disaster victims, offering

- 1 emergency home repair loans, and extending a Five Million Dollar (\$5,000,000)
- 2 loan to the government of Guam for typhoon relief; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the original location of the newly established business was a
- 4 pre-fabricated building in Hagåtña, and by 1978, "Bankon Ifit" had expanded to a
- 5 second branch in Tamuning; and
- 6 WHEREAS, in the 1980s, "Bankon Ifit" continued its rapid growth, opening
- 7 seven (7) new branches in Dededo and Tumon Bay, Guam; San Francisco,
- 8 California; Garapan, Saipan; the islands of Rota and Tinian; and in Ebeye,
- 9 Kwajalein; and
- 10 WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" also acquired Bank of America's branches in the
- 11 Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI), Eastern Caroline and
- 12 the Marshall Islands; and the American Savings and Loan Association branches
- in Belau and Pohnpei; and
- 14 WHEREAS, by the end of the 1980s, "Bankon Ifit" had introduced the first
- 15 automated teller machines (ATMs) in Guam, providing twenty-four (24) hour
- 16 banking to their customers; and Bank of Guam's assets exceeded Three Hundred
- 17 Million Dollars (\$300,000,000), with profits topping Six Million Dollars
- 18 (\$6,000,000); and
- 19 WHEREAS, in the 1990s, "Bankon Ifit" opened a historic island landmark,
- 20 their ten (10)-storey headquarters building in Hagåtña, one of the island's most
- 21 recognizable landmarks; launched Telephone Voice Banking; and contributed
- 22 One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to the American Red Cross following
- 23 the aftermath of Super Typhoon Paka; and

1 WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" transitioned smoothly into the new millennium, 2 the first decade of which brought the twin challenges of the loss of founder Mr. 3 Jesus S. Leon Guerrero, who passed away on August 27, 2002, and Mr. Anthony A. Leon Guerrero, eldest son of Mr. Leon Guerrero, who served as Vice 4 5 Chairman of the Board, President and Chief Executive Officer from 1985 until 6 2002, when he became Chairman of the Board, and held all three positions until 7 his untimely passing on October 9, 2005; and 8 WHEREAS, despite the loss of the "Bankon Ifit" leadership, the Leon 9 Guerrero and Bank of Guam families persevered in the first decade of the new 10 millennium, with the elevation of Ms. Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero, a former senator in the 24th, 26th, 27th, and 28th Guam Legislatures, to the positions of Board 11 12 Chair, President, and Chief Executive Officer on April 3, 2006; and 13 WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" continued its expansion, opening Primevest 14 Financial and BGInsurance; establishing two more bank branches in Yap and 15 Kosrae; opened its new Mangilao branch on January 30, 2012, continuing twenty-16 one (21) years of presence in the village; completed construction of a branch in 17 Pohnpei; launched internet banking; established the groundwork for a Virtual 18 Private Network (VPN); began Voice Over Internet Technology (VOIP) 19 conversion; and expanded its network of ATMs to more than eighty (80) 20 machines, reaching from San Francisco to the Federated States of Micronesia; and formed the Bank Guam Holding Company, all while submitting winning Small 21 Business Association (SBA) nominations; and 22 WHEREAS, in contributing to the community, "Bankon Ifit" hosted the 5K 23 24 Ifit Run for Guam Cancer Care on March 10, 2012 to assist local nonprofit

organizations in helping Guam's cancer patients; and has entered an awardwinning team for this year's Relay for Life; and

WHEREAS, education is a priority of "Bankon Ifit," with twenty (20) of its officers having been sent to Pacific Coast Banking School, seventy-three (73) staffers having received college degrees, while thirteen (13) have postgraduate degrees; and "Bankon Ifit" will be awarding and matching a Five Thousand Dollar (\$5,000) Accel Education Grant to issue Two Thousand Dollar (\$2,000) awards for five (5) graduating high school seniors, in addition to offering generous tuition assistance to its employees, eight of whom are currently enrolled in school this year; and

WHEREAS, "Bankon Ifit" has matured into a billion-dollar financial institution, with a reach that spans the broad Pacific with roots firmly planted in our island home; and now, at the mark of its fortieth (40th) anniversary, "Bankon Ifit" celebrates its local staff, with its Senior Management having over Two Hundred (200) years of financial services experience; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that *I Mina'trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan*, on behalf of the people of Guam, does hereby commend and congratulate the Bank of Guam, and the entire Leon Guerrero and Bank of Guam Families on the occasion of the fortieth (40th) anniversary of "Bankon Ifit," which is among Guam's most iconic financial institutions; and to further expressing a most sincere *un dangkolo na Si Yu'os ma'åse'* for the continued contributions of "Bankon Ifit" to the growth and progress of our island's economy, culture and people; and be it further
