PAK KIM LAM TAN ON THE OCCASION OF THE 40<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF TAN HOLDINGS IN GUAM, AND THE 30<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF TAN HOLDINGS IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE NORTHERN MARIANAS ISLANDS, AND RECOGNIZING THEIR BUSINESS SUCCESSES AND CONCERN FOR THEIR ADOPTED COMMUNITIES.

- 3 WHEREAS, Dr. Tan Siu Lin's family business, Luen Thai Shipping and
- 4 Trading, began its expansion from its home base in Hong Kong to the Western
- 5 Pacific; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Dr. Tan began exploring business ventures in Guam and
- 7 Saipan and established an agency partnership with Saipan Shipping, and in
- 8 1972 formed L&T Guam Corporation and moved to Guam with his family to
- 9 pursue further opportunities in our region; and
- 10 WHEREAS, L&T Guam Corporation began marketing building materials
- and food products to well known companies like Joeten Enterprises and Sablan
- 12 Construction, and in 1973 began distributing Kung Fu movies from Hong Kong,
- 13 the films eventually playing in theaters in both Guam and Saipan; and

WHEREAS, the films were so popular that the distribution soon extended to Tinian, Rota, the FSM, Palau, Majuro, the Solomon Islands, Fiji, Tonga, Nauru, Samoa and many other Pacific islands, eventually setting up distribution offices in the United States and South America; and

WHEREAS, L&T Guam Corporation In 1974 a cargo ship, the S.S. Roma, was purchased from Saipan Shipping to compliment the company's scrap material, building material, trading and other businesses, L&T also selling food items to Payless and other markets; and

WHEREAS, L&T's next venture was with an old friend in Guam, Mr. Charlie Wong of Southern Pacific, Inc. (SPI), to build a warehouse for rental income as well as for marketing building materials; and

WHEREAS, former CNMI Governor Pedro P. Tenorio invited Dr. Tan to explore investment in Saipan in 1982, setting up L&T International Corporation in that same year, and establishing their first garment factory in Saipan in 1983, and over the years continued reinvesting in additional businesses; and

WHEREAS, with hard work and united efforts from sons Henry, Willie, Raymond and Jerry, along with loyal colleagues, investments were made in more than a dozen industries extending from the Western Pacific and South Asia to the continental United States; and

WHEREAS, although the business environment in Saipan has changed and the apparel business is now closed, their hearts are still with Saipan, and they will continue to invest not only in business but also in the community, during good times and bad, Dr. Tan believing his family responsibility is to help their adopted home, and they are venturing into a new industry, Saipan Air, which they hope will help bring more tourists to the CNMI; and

WHEREAS, the causes most dear to Dr. Tan's heart continue to be education and caring for the community, both being worthwhile investments

- 2 spread throughout the year, that will benefit the students of the CNMI and
- 3 many others most in need, now, therefore, be it
