



**RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING AND HONORING  
MRS. FELICIDAD ALMONTE CASTILLO AS SHE  
CELEBRATES THE ONE HUNDRETH (100<sup>TH</sup>) YEAR  
OF HER LIFE AND FURTHER COMMENDING HER  
AS A “2012 SENIOR CITIZENS MONTH  
CENTENARIAN.”**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF**

**WHEREAS;** Mrs. Felicidad Almonte Castillo, known to her family and friends as “Fely” was born on October 12, 1912 in the small town of Mangaldan of Pangasinan, Philippines; and

**WHEREAS,** in 1934 “Fely” married Mr. Espiritu P. “Pedro” Castillo, a fisherman in her village, where together they relied on the sea to support themselves and their family; and

1           **WHEREAS**, while her husband fished, “Fely” enjoyed helping by selling  
2 the fish in the village and was able to successfully sell their fish because of her  
3 friendly personality; and

4           **WHEREAS**, after many years of fishing in their home village the fish  
5 market declined dramatically due to extensive dynamiting around the area. “Fely  
6 “and her husband were forced to buy and sell fish in surrounding villages and were  
7 still able to sustain their five (5) children; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Mr. and Mrs. Castillo moved to Guam in 1987 and now live  
9 with their son Ricardo A. Castillo in the village of Yigo; and

10          **WHEREAS**, “Fely” and her husband became active members of the senior  
11 citizens community of Guam by frequenting the Yigo Senior Citizens Center  
12 where the learned to dance, sing and exercise for fun; and

13          **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Castillo would often share her stories with her family of  
14 the active life at the Yigo Senior Citizens Center and the many outings they  
15 enjoyed, such as luncheons at local hotels; and

16          **WHEREAS**, she was an avid attendee of the senior center until she recently  
17 experienced a fall that left her with a fractured hip. “Fely” spent some time in the  
18 Guam Memorial Hospital Skilled Nursing Unit and is now recuperating  
19 comfortably at home where nurses and friends from the senior center come to visit  
20 her several times a week; and

21          **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Castillo enjoys mangos and bitter melon as her favorite  
22 fresh produce to keep her healthy, and also enjoys playing card games and bingo to  
23 keep her busy; and

24          **WHEREAS**, “Fely” and her husband are blessed with their greatest  
25 treasure, their family of sixteen (16) grandchildren and nineteen (19) great  
26 grandchildren; and now, therefore be it

1       **RESOLVED**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, recognize  
2 and commend Mrs. Felicidad Almonte Castillo as a “2012 Senior Citizens’ Month  
3 Centenarian” and extend a warm *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu’os Ma’ase’* for her  
4 contributions to the island of Guam; and be it further

5       **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairman of the Committee on  
6 Rules certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to , the adoption hereof,  
7 and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to Mrs. Felicidad Almonte
