WHEREAS, being the eldest child, a lot of responsibilities were 10 placed on "Tan Ama", which included having to look after her siblings, 11 upkeep of the family home, laundry, sewing and preparing meals. She 12 learned to cook and sew from her grandmother, her teacher and mentor, and 13 the memories of her grandmother impacted her relationship with her family, 14 devoting her entire life to caring for her family; and 15 WHEREAS, "Tan Ama" loved to cook, sew, and garden. She did all 16 her cooking the traditional way, cooking over a wood-burning stove. She is 17 well-known for her delicious Chamorro Cake; and 18 WHEREAS, her favorite food dish is fish cooked in any manner, as 19 she is not too keen with red meat. Amongst her other favorite dishes, 20 includes atuli (soup made of corn), gollai åpan lemmai (bread fruit cooked 21 in coconut milk), taro, bananas, and eating lots of vegetables; and 22 WHEREAS, as a seamstress, "Tan Ama" had no need to buy clothing 23 for her family, sewing all their clothes; and 24 WHEREAS, although her mobility is very limited today, she loves 25 being outdoors. In her stronger days, she loved gardening vegetables and 26 flowers. Her favorite flower is the pink Flores Rosa; 27 WHEREAS, Tan Ama is a member of the Inarajan Christian Mothers 28
