1 WHEREAS, Preciosa Reyes Ulloa was born to †Maria Delos Reyes

2 and [†]Vicente Ulloa, in the village of Talofofo on October 24, 1910; and

WHEREAS, she being the eldest of six (6) children had many responsibilities growing up and naturally fell into the role as a caregiver, as well as being seen as a mother figure because she worked tirelessly to ensure that everyone in her family was fine by attending to their individual needs; and

8 WHEREAS, Preciosa married Felix Taitague and they had two (2)
9 children together, †Josefa and David; and

10 WHEREAS, after the passing of her first husband at an early age, 11 Preciosa married Mr. Vicente Castro in 1945 and together they had five (5) Their five (5) children are Joseph, [†]Frank, [†]Pedro, Arthur and 12 children. Maria; and 13 WHEREAS, as a mother, she loved and provided for the physical and 14 emotional needs of her children. Even as her children became adults, 15 16 Preciosa always felt obliged to continue loving and caring for them. ; and WHEREAS, despite Preciosa's second marriage ending in a divorce 17 sometime in 1977, she was there to care for him on the weekends when he 18 19 was gravely ill with cancer, which demonstrated her caring and forgiving nature; and 20 WHEREAS, Ms. Ulloa worked as a Housekeeper for the late 21 Governor Carlos G. Camacho, then later, for his brother Luis Camacho in 22 Windward Hills; and 23 WHEREAS, Preciosa is described as very neat and organized as 24 evidenced by her choice of work and was not one to complain. She took it 25 upon herself to ensure that things were done properly. She worked hard and 26 took pride in the quality of work that she produced; and 27 WHEREAS, in 1994, while at work, she experienced a stroke where 28 shefell down and injured her head. As a result of the stroke, Preciosa's 29 independence was affected in the process; and 30

WHEREAS, at that time, her medical doctor predicted that she 31 possibly had six (6) months to live. Given the nature of Preciosa's health, 32 the family felt that it was in the best interest of Preciosa to receive the 33 required care at Saint Dominic's Senior Care Home. To date, after almost 34 eighteen (18) years later, Preciosa has lived over the life expectancy that her 35 doctor predicted and her family is looking forward in celebrating her one 36 hundred and second (102nd) birthday on October 24, 2012; and 37 WHEREAS. Preciosa's longevity was attributed to taking care of 38 39 herself and daily walks to church for prayers before the 7:00am mass in Talofofo; and 40 WHEREAS, Preciosa's devotion to her faith and dedication to her 41 family is evident today, as she is blessed with twenty-seven (27) 42 grandchildren, forty (40) great grandchildren, eighteen (18) great-great 43 grandchildren, and two (2) great-great-great grandchildren; and 44 WHEREAS, people who have known Preciosa would describe her as 45 a very simple, patient, graceful, devoted, and quiet woman who dedicated 46 her life to her faith, family and work ; and now therefore, be it 47 RESOLVED, I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan Guåhan, does 48 hereby, on behalf of the People of Guam, recognize and honor Ms. Preciosa 49 Reves Ulloa on one hundred and two (102) years of life dedicated to her 50 faith and family; and be it further 51
