**WHEREAS**, June Q. Pangelinan was born on June 23, 1958 and is a 1977 graduate of George Washington High School; and

**WHEREAS**, June is the wife of the late John Untalan Pangelinan "Familian Kotla" from Agana Heights; and

**WHEREAS**, June and her late husband are the proud parents of three children; John-Vincent, Jason and Janessa and grand parents of six grand children; and

**WHEREAS**, June began her career with the Government of Guam via the Agana Heights Mayor's Office on January 4, 1993 where she served as the Municipal Clerk for Mayor Paul M. McDonald; and

**WHEREAS**, as the Municipal Clerk for the Agana Heights Mayor's Office, June's duties and responsibilities included but were not limited to, assisting constituents and visitors on a daily basis determining their needs and directing

1 them accordingly; and maintaining files on all matters relating to the Office of the  
2 Mayor; as well as providing additional support to the Administrative Assistant; and

3 **WHEREAS**, it was on October 2, 2006 when June was elevated to the  
4 position of Administrative Assistant for the Agana Heights Mayor's Office, and  
5 held that position until her departure on April 20, 2012; and

6 **WHEREAS**, as the Administrative Assistant for Agana Heights Mayor's  
7 Office, June's duties and responsibilities included but were not limited to preparing  
8 all correspondences for the Mayor; preparing all procurement documents;  
9 communicating with vendors on behalf of the Mayor; serving as a liaison between  
10 the Mayor's office and various GovGuam departments and agencies; Military  
11 Sister Commands and the private sector; and

12 **WHEREAS**, outside of the Mayor's office operations, June provided  
13 administrative, as well as logistical support for many community functions and  
14 events sponsored by or in part by the Agana Heights Mayor's office; now,  
15 therefore be it;

17 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, recognize the contributions of Mrs. June  
18 Q. Pangelinan upon her departure from the Agana Heights Mayor's Office; and to
