## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA' TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Angustia Baza Tainatongo Rivera was born on September 22, 1934 in the Village of Merizo, where she later moved to live in Agat, and then eventually moving to Mangilao where she resided since 1969; and

WHEREAS, Angustia Baza Tainatongo Rivera, was fondly known to her brothers and sisters as "Angustia"; to her Grandchildren as "Grandma Rivera"; to her nieces and nephews "Auntie Uta or Auntie Gus"; to her friends and business associates as "Angie" and to God as "Angel"; and

WHEREAS, Angustia is the daughter of Gregorio S.N. Tainatongo and Dolores Baza Tainatongo, the 3rd oldest of 10 children, with 6 brothers: Jose (dec); Vicente (Alabama); Ramon (Merizo); Gregorio (Merizo); Vinancio (Washington); and Geronimo (Merizo); and 3 sisters: Maria (dec); Dolores (Agana Springs); and Jasanhina (Washington); and

Josephine (Washington); and

WHEREAS, Angustia was previously married to Jesus S. Rivera and were the proud parents of four (4) children; namely: Roland, Ralph, Eloise and Pinky; and

WHEREAS, for over 42 years, Angustia was an Independent Business Owner working as a Mary Kay beauty consultant, whereby she ranked #93 (top 100) out of 1.8 million Mary Kay consultants world-wide; and

WHEREAS, Angustia was devoted to God, her family, and her career, whereby her life revolved around helping others in need, she was an educator of "work for what you need", a mentor of "quit feeling sorry for yourself and get up and do something about it"; and

WHEREAS, Angustia carried out the Corporal Works of Mercy by feeding those who were hungry, giving to those who were thirsty, sheltering those who were homeless, clothing those who were naked, and visiting those who were sick; and

WHEREAS, many times Angustia would literally drive around the island in search of the homeless, bring them home and provide them with essentials as well as a place of respite from the elements, and even with the mere income she was making, she would create small jobs around the house so that these individuals would work and she would give them some money so that they can learn how to work and earn a living; and

WHEREAS, Angustia was a true servant of the Lord and spent many years caring for her children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren, always teaching them to love one another and to take care of each other, and to care for the less fortunate and to treat them with dignity and respect; and

WHEREAS, if there is one memory that her children have of their mother is that Angustia was always smiling and was never judgmental – always supporting

- their mistakes and flaws; and
- 3 WHEREAS, as she carried out her faith, Angustia's involvement in church
- 4 became more and more visible, she was a Christian Mother and a devotee of the
- 5 Devine Mercy, and as a devotee, she knew that "one lets the love and mercy of
- 6 God flow through one's own heart towards those who need it"; and
- WHEREAS, Angustia always showed kindness to all the people she met,
- 8 offering her goodness to the many people she has touched in her lifetime helping
- 9 hundreds of people through her work with the homeless; and
- 10 WHEREAS, it was on April 15, 2012 that Angustia Baza Tainatongo
- Rivera passed away at the age of 77 years, whereby her passing leaves a void that
- will be felt for many years to come, in both the family she loved and the island she
- so selflessly served; now, therefore be it;
