BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Guam has been blessed with a vibrant ocean environment that has provided many leisure opportunities for its people for generations, recreational boating having become one of the island's favorite ways to relax with family and friends; and

WHEREAS, safe boating practices are extremely important to people who live in Guam, and are also important to the thousands of visitors to our island, because the lives of both boaters and non-boaters can be affected by accidents at sea, with many precious lives having been needlessly lost over the years, and much valuable property being damaged or destroyed, in boating, fishing, paddling, jet skiing and other accidents; and

WHEREAS, of particular concern in recent years have been the many occurrences of boating accidents resulting from preventable causes, such as the simple failure to wear life jackets, or the lack of even basic knowledge concerning boating and marine safety, of which every boating participant should be aware; and

WHEREAS, to increase the level of safety, numerous government agencies, private groups, and community organizations are involved in promoting safe boating practices by educating vessel operators about ocean safety principles, and by offering safe boating courses, conducting search and rescue missions, examining boats for the presence of safety equipment, and participating in other activities to keep Guam's waters safe; and

WHEREAS, each year, *National Safe Boating Week* is observed across the United States and throughout its territories, to spread a message of boating safety and to encourage boater education relative to safe boating practices, including: knowing how to properly wear a life jacket; carrying proper safety equipment on board a vessel, including a VHF radio or Emergency Position-Indicating Radio Beacons (EPIRB's); obtaining boating safety education; and having a Vessel Safety Check; now, therefore, be it
