1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF**  
2 ***I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***  
3           **WHEREAS,** the Lions Clubs International District 204 is a group of 23  
4 Lions Clubs from Guam, Saipan, Marshall Islands and Pohnpei. The oldest of  
5 which is the Guam Marianas Lions Club which has been in existence for 63 years;

7           **WHEREAS,** the Region 1 of the Lions Club International District 204 is  
8 composed of: Marianas Lions Club, Guahan Lions Club, Paradise Lions Club,  
9 Stars Lions Club, Harmony Lions Club, Asia-Pacific Lions Club, Merizo Southern
