School of Nursing Class of '62 are the Golden Jubilarians of U.P. in 2012; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Marcos was sent to Beth Israel Hospital in 10 Newark, New Jersey, for a Foreign Exchange Nurse Program and 11 Received credit for Post Graduate Studies in Nursing Medical-Surgical 12 and she has helped to redefine the role of immigrant professional women in their second (2nd) home; and 13 WHEREAS, Mrs. Marcos earned two (2) semester credits for 14 enrichment courses in Personnel Supervision, Interpersonal Relationship, 15

- 3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Marcos was an HML Plan Manager and an Asia-
- 4 Pacific Region Claims Manager, responsible for laying out the planning,
- 5 organizing, staffing and generally controlling the Asia-Pacific Region
- 6 Claims Department; and
- 7 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Marcos' work experience has provided the
- 8 organization and the necessary resources to manage effectively and
- 9 efficiently, her knowledge of the workmen's compensation, Public
- 10 Liability, Privacy Act, and Medicare regulations placing her in a position of
- 11 great importance; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Marcos was the Vice-Chairperson of the Board of
- 13 Directors of the Airport Authority and has been exposed to both the
- 14 civilian and military communities in Guam; She has been the Acting Judge
- 15 for an Oratorical Contest for DYA's Youth Month, Chairperson of the
- 16 Entertainment Committee for the 1995 Liberation Day Activities and
- 17 Chairperson of the Gupot Magalahi Entertainment Committee; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Marcos has been the Vice-President of the Guam
- 19 PTA, Vice-President of the Filipino Community of Guam, President of
- 20 Simon Sanchez High School PTA, Chairperson of Miss Guam World,
- 21 Chairperson of Kundirana Charity Foundation, Vice-President of the Guam
- 22 Beautification Association, former President of Novo Ecijano Association of
- 23 Guam, Past President of the Guam Chapter's American Cancer Society,
- 24 Charter Board Member of the Salvation Army, Past President of the
- 25 Federation of Asian and Pacific People of Guam, First (1st) Filipina to be a

member of the Rotary Club of Tumon Bay in 1988 and has been on the 1

2 Board of Trustees of the Filipino Community of Guam since 2008; and

3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Marcos has received various certificates from FHP, 4 Inc., for her (15) fifteen years of service and various awards including the University of the Philippines, Bristol Myers Squibb, the Filipino 5 6 Community of Guam, the Guam Heart Association, the Beauty World Guam, Ltd., Naval Station Parish Council and the United States Navy and 7 8 has received a "Presidential Award", and 1997 Most Outstanding Women's 9 Award by the Government of Guam's Bureau of Women's Affairs, 1999 10 Honoree of International Who's Who of Professional and Business Women 11 and now elected for a 4th time as the President of University of the 12 Philippines Alumni Association of Guam; and 13
