1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA' TRENTAI***

3           **WHEREAS**, the Vision for ESGR is to develop and promote a culture in which all  
4 American employers support and value the military service of their employees with  
5 ESGR as the principal advocate for the Department of Defense; and

6           **WHEREAS**, September 10 through September 14, 2012, has been proclaimed  
7 nationally and on Guam, as Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve Week; and

8           **WHEREAS**, the anniversary of the 9/11 attacks in New York and the Pentagon,  
9 have reminded us that hundreds and thousands of our fellow citizen-service members  
10 continue to serve and maintain constant vigilance in order to protect our Freedom and  
11 American way of life; and

1           **WHEREAS**, standing tall among these troops are our nation's National Guard  
2   and Reserve forces, which continue to serve our island and country with distinction.  
3   Our National Guardsmen and Reservists continue to serve on active duty on every  
4   front of the Global War on Terror; and

5           **WHEREAS**, almost half of our military force resides in the Reserve Components,  
6   which is comprised of the National Guard and Reserve; and

7           **WHEREAS**, the organization, the Guam-CNMI Committee for Employer  
8   Support of the Guard and Reserve, or ESGR, its Volunteers and employers support this  
9   effort and provide a degree of comfort for members of the National Guard and Reserve  
10   so they can focus on their military mission without worrying about their civilian jobs at  
11   home; and
