7 Development Trainee with the Department of Labor; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in October 1979, Annie moved to the Department of
9 Administration, Division of Accounts as a Clerk II; and

10 **WHEREAS**, throughout Annie’s career at the Department of
11 Administration, she has progressed and will retire with the position of Accounting
12 Technician III; and

1 **WHEREAS**, throughout Annie’s career at the Department of
2 Administration, she has assisted in developing the reconciliation framework
3 between the Department of Administration and the Customs and Quarantine
4 Agency; Travel payments and advances; Cost of Living Allowances and
5 Supplemental Annuity Retiree payments and collections from autonomous
6 agencies; and Fuel and Supplies billings and collections; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Annie has left a lasting legacy amongst her professional
8 colleagues, friends and family that will continue even as she proudly retires from a
9 wonderful career at the Department of Administration; and

10 **WHEREAS**, Annie has also dedicated much of her spare time as a
11 dedicated, active and devout Catholic and parishioner of the Santa Teresita Church
12 in Mangilao; and has been assisting with the preparation of mass, organization of
13 parish activities, cleaning of the Santa Teresita Church, and assists with praying
14 the Rosary to the Blessed Mother throughout the community; and has been a
15 member of the Legion of Mary for over fifteen (15) years and has devoted endless
16 hours visiting and praying for the sick at the Skilled Nursing Unit, St. Dominic’s
