3           **WHEREAS**, Liguan Elementary School was established and opened its  
4 doors on August 21, 2008 and is now celebrating its 5<sup>th</sup> year of operation. The  
5 school is located at 237 North Chalan Liguan, in the subdivision of Liguan Terrace  
6 in the village of Dededo; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Liguan Elementary School services grades Kindergarten to 5<sup>th</sup>  
8 grade with a population of approximately 633 students from the areas of Liguan  
9 Terrace Subdivision, Harmon Sunset Gardens Apartments, right side of route 15,  
10 Great Mart and surrounding areas of Great Mart, Tranquilo and Dikiki courts, and  
11 Tun Francisco subdivision across the soccer field and Guam Sports Complex; and

12           **WHEREAS**, the school is an enclosed campus which consists of 33  
13 classrooms, a dining hall, satellite kitchen, library, administrative offices, electrical  
14 maintenance, storage facilities and generator room provided to surround students

1 with the best possible environment for learning. Students also benefit from Ligan

3 Reading Reform Program, English as a Second Language Program, Special  
4 Education Program, Chamorro Program, Department of Education Extended Day  
5 (DEED) Program, Summer School Program, Parent Teacher Organization, Gifted  
6 and Talented Education (GATE) Program; and
