Relative to commending and congratulating Mrs. Jane Peredo Sasai for her numerous outstanding achievements as a civilian assigned to the 36th Communications Squadron, 36th Mission Support Group, 36th Wing, Andersen Air Force Base, Guam, from June 15, 1978 to September 30, 2012, her actions distinguishing both herself and the command for which she worked, and to extend best wishes to her and her family upon her retirement.

3 WHEREAS, Jane Peredo Sasai, a civilian employee assigned to the
4 36th Communications Squadron, 36th Mission Support Group, 36th Wing,
5 at Andersen Air Force Base in Guam, has distinguished herself through
6 her outstanding actions and achievements during her 34 years of service
7 with the United States Air Force and the 36th Wing; and

8 WHEREAS, throughout her career, Ms Sasai was instrumental in
9 developing the Base Equipment Custodian program, training over four
10 thousand (4,000) individuals, and ensuring accountability for more than
11 ten thousand (10,000) computer assets valued at more than ten million
12 dollars (\$10,000,000); and

13 WHEREAS, by way of the Department of Defense's "Computers for
14 Learning" program, Ms Sasai assisted in the donation of over two

1 thousand five hundred (2,500) computer systems to the Guam Public
2 School System, helping thousands of students with their education and
3 simultaneously assisting them with the tools to achieve their full
4 potential; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Ms Sasai received numerous "Civilian of the Quarter"
6 Awards from the 36th Wing as a result of her outstanding work ethic, and
7 in 1994 she was named a member of the Department of the Air Force's
8 "Quality Team of the Year," and was twice selected "Civilian of the Year,"
9 once by the 36th Mission Support Group in 2006, and once by the 36th
10 Communications Squadron in 2007; and

11 **WHEREAS**, among her other achievements are: ten Performance
12 Awards, two Notable Achievement Awards, two Sustain Superior
13 Performance Awards, recognition for her assistance provided to the
14 Simon Sanchez High School Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps
15 Program, her contributions to Catholic Schools Week, recognition for
16 promoting cultural awareness to the military and civilian communities,
17 and was selected "Lady of the Year" by the Military Order of the Purple
18 Heart Ladies Auxiliary; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Ms Sasai is the daughter of Adela G. Peredo and the
20 late Antonio Peredo, and has been married to David H. Sasai, since
21 August of 2000; and

22 **WHEREAS**, her children and stepchildren are Junella and John
23 Sgro, Joleen and Kenneth Castro, Janae Certeza, Joseph D. Certeza,
24 Dennis and Shanda Sasai, Devin and Michelle Sasai, Matthew Sasai; and
25 MichieAnna Sasai; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in spite of her well earned and deserved retirement, Ms
2 Sasai continues to be active in the community as a member of the Military
3 Order of the Purple Heart and the Saint Francis Choir, and her
4 outstanding devotion and accomplishments reflect great credit upon
5 herself, her family, her island, and also upon the United States Air Force;
6 now, therefore, be it

8 behalf of the people of Guam, does hereby extend its sincere appreciation
9 and most heartfelt thanks to Ms Jane Peredo Sasai for her citizenship,
