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Relative to commending and expressing an Un Dångkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse' to Inafa'måolek for their selfless commitment and fine work in reaching out and positively touching the lives of our island community; and to further recognizing October, 2012 as Mediation Month for the Island of Guam and we call this observance to the attention of all of our citizens of Guam

## 1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I 2 *MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:*

3 **WHEREAS**, *Inafa'måolek's* vision is to enhance peacemaking and reduce

4 violence related litigation through advocacy, mediation, end education; and

5 WHEREAS, *Inafa'måolek* mission is dedicated to reducing violence 6 related litigations and fostering peace and harmony in schools, Workplaces, 7 and communities; and

8 WHEREAS, Since 1975, *Inafa'måolek* is Guam's only organization 9 dedicated exclusively to peacemaking, especially dispute settlement services 10 (such as mediation and restorative justice) and conflict resolution training for 11 all ages; and WHEREAS, *Inafa'måolek* has trained and helped establish peer
 mediation programs in more than 30 Guam schools from elementary to high
 school; and,

WHEREAS, the heart and soul of the work of *Inafa'måolek is* its focus on
mediating conflicts, many referred by Superior Court Judges; and

6 WHEREAS, *Inafa'måolek* has provided mediation programs for all
7 sectors of Guam's community; and,

WHEREAS, In November 1994 Inafa'måolek (IM) conducted its first Peer 8 9 Mediation training for 31 students from John F. Kennedy High School. That 10 Spring IM conducted its first middle school training and the following fall did 11 its first elementary training. In subsequent years IM conducted at least ten 12 such 10-hour trainings every school year...totaling over 150 trainings altogether inclusive of over 30 public, private and Department of Defense 13 14 Schools throughout Guam. In support of Peer Mediation, Inafa'måolek provides an array of specialized conflict resolution workshops for students 15 including: Date Rape/Dating Violence, Bullying, Hate Crimes (Racial-Ethnic 16 Conflict), Suicide, Sexual Harassment, Rumors & Gossip, Peer Pressure & 17 18 Smoking (Drugs/Drunk Driving/Drag Racing), Bulimia, and Bystander 19 Response ("Good Samaritan"); and

WHEREAS, the hallmarks of *Inafa'måolek* workshops are the use of drama (Peace Theatre skits) and *Inafa'måolek* youthful training team for other stakeholders within the schools, such as: "Peer Mediation Awareness" for parents; and "Creating a Safe School Climate" workshops for School Aides (support staff); and Staff Development presentations for faculty and school administrators; now therefore, be it

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1 **RESOLVED,** that the Committee on Rules of I *Mina'Trentai Unu Na* 2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people 3 of Guam does hereby recognize October, 2012 as **Mediation Month** for the 4 Island of Guam and we call this observance to the attention of all of our 5 citizens of Guam; and be it further

6 **RESOLVED,** that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules 7 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof and that copies of 8 the same be thereafter transmitted to the *Inafa'måolek Conciliation* and to the 9 Honorable Edward B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahen Guåhan*.
