WHEREAS, in 1995, Colonel Martin was assigned to the Medical ffice in NASA, Kennedy Space Center. In August 1998, he was the commander for Aerospace Medicine Flight 36 Medical Group in Andersen Air Force Base in Guam. He was assigned to various Air Force Bases and duties and was reassigned to Guam from December 2006 through 2008 and served the healthcare needs of the people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, his family, friends and Guam Medical Society comes together to honor and remember the invaluable services that Colonel George Martin has contributed to the healthcare of the people of our island; and now, therefore be it
