1       **WHEREAS**, School Principals are educational leaders who serve as personnel  
2 managers, budget managers, facilities managers, and administrators of legal and  
3 contractual obligations in order to ensure that the physical plant and operations help  
4 enable every child to attain an adequate education in a safe and healthy learning  
5 environment; and

6       **WHEREAS**, School Principals are educational leaders who serve as  
7 community builders who work collaboratively with families, civic organizations,  
8 government, the business industry, and other stakeholders in order to develop and  
9 implement a clear vision and mission and respond to the diverse needs of the  
10 classroom and school community; and

11       **WHEREAS**, School Principals are educational leaders who serve as fine  
12 examples for students, faculty, and staff by acting with integrity, fairness, high ethical  
13 standards; and

14       **WHEREAS**, School Principals serve as leaders at the ‘front line’ of school  
15 reform, continuous improvement, and the mobilization of the school community in  
16 promoting educational excellence and in responding to threats and other emergencies  
17 at the school; now therefore, be it
