passed away on August 26, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Ramon Arevalo Tinsay completed medical school at  
University of Santo Tomas in Manila, Philippines in 1954. He then completed his  
residency at Good Samaritan Hospital in Cincinnati Ohio in 1962, specializing in  
General Vascular Surgery; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Ramon Arevalo Tinsay began his service on Guam in 1965  
as a surgeon at the Guam Memorial Hospital. He was then a physician at the  
Catholic Medical Center in Agaña from 1966 until 1975; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Ramon Arevalo Tinsay was the founder of the Good  
Samaritan Clinic in Tamuning, Guam which opened its doors in 1975; and

1       **WHEREAS**, his family, friends and Guam Medical Society have come  
2 together to honor and remember the invaluable services that Dr. Ramon Arevalo  
3 Tinsay has contributed to the healthcare of the people of our island; and now,
