began on February 8, 1988, where she served as the Administrative Secretary I for the

Probation Division, and later as the Administrative Secretary II for the Marshals

Division. On December 9, 1990, Ms. Antonita Q. Cruz was appointed to Deputy

resigned on December 3, 1994 and a year later on September 30, 1995 she was reemployed as Deputy Marshal II; and

WHEREAS, throughout her career, Ms. Antonita Q. Cruz received numerous training including Pistol Firearms Training, Drug Identification/Field Training, Substance Abuse Awareness, Courthouse/Courtroom Security Training, Family Violence Training, Firearms Qualifications Course (Phase I and II), Cell Extraction & Prisoner Handling, Judicious Use of Deadly Force, Ethics and Custer Service in the Courts, EEO Sexual Harassment Training and Nonviolent Crisis Intervention Training; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Antonita Q. Cruz received many letters of commendations recognizing her outstanding performance as an employee of the Court, notably from Presiding Judge Alberto C.
