Relative to commending and congratulating Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle on the occasion of his retirement from the government of Guam after twenty-seven (27) years of dedicated service to the Guam Police Department and the Unified Judiciary of Guam; and to further extending a most sincere *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to his family in recognition of their support of his service to the people of Guam as a Deputy Marshal Supervisor.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle was born on January 1, 1965 in San Jose,
4 California and is married to Monica Blaz Wintterle, and both are the proud parents of
5 Jacqueline, Phillip, Christopher and Victoria; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle began his career in public service with
7 the government of Guam, as a Police Officer I with the Guam Police Department, from
8 February 25, 1985 to September 29, 1989; and

9 WHEREAS, in October 1989, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle began working for the
10 Judiciary of Guam as an Alternative Sentencing Officer I, a position which was changed
11 to Deputy Marshal I a few days later. After a year, Mr. Wintterle was promoted to

Deputy Marshal II and three (3) years later was promoted to Deputy Marshal III. On September 30, 1995, Mr. Wintterle was promoted to Deputy Marshal Supervisor and served as the Acting Deputy Chief Marshal on three (3) occasions which took place from September 8-17, 2003, September 23 to December 24, 2012, and January 4-17, 2006. Whenever necessary, Mr. Winterle served as acting Chief Marshal of the Court; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle was a recipient of the Pedro "Doc" Sanchez Scholarship and received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Public Administration on December 19, 1997, and three (3) years later he earned a Master of Public Administration Degree on December 17, 2000 from the University of Guam in Mangilao; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure with the Unified Judiciary of Guam, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle received a variety of training that served him well as an employee of the Court. In 2002, his training included Domestic Violence Train-the-Trainer Program, Monadock Expandable Baton Basic Course and Combat Tracking Levels 1 & II Course. In 2004, Mr. Wintterle completed training which included: Instructor courses for OCAT, PATH, and MEB and Judicious Use of Deadly Force Training. The following year, in 2005, Mr. Wintterle received training from the Leadership Institute in Judicial Education and Supervisory Training on Performance Appraisals. In 2006, Mr. Wintterle received training for the 2006 Pacific Law Enforcement Drug Summit, in 2007, for the PJC 2nd

31 Court Administrators Conference and in 2008, Dignitary Protection Course, Supervision
32 & Leadership Training and EEO/Sexual Harassment Supervisory Training; and

33 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle was acknowledged for his hard work and
34 dedication through many commendations to include on November 11, 1991, a
35 Commendation for participating in the Security provided in the Grand Opening of the
36 Guam Judicial Center, Commendation on Warrant of Arrest Search on August 5, 1993,
37 and a Letter of Commendation regarding Jury Sequestration on June 12, 2000; and

38 **WHEREAS**, After twenty-seven (27) years, seven (7) months and eight (8) days
39 of service with the Guam Police Department and the Unified Judiciary of Guam, Mr.
40 Michael Lee Wintterle retired from government of Guam service on October 5, 2012 as
41 Deputy Marshal Supervisor, Unified Judiciary of Guam; and therefore be it

42 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina' Trentai Unu na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
43 behalf of the people of Guam, commends and congratulates Mr. Michael Lee Wintterle
44 on the occasion of his retirement from the government of Guam, after dedicating more
45 than twenty-seven (27) years of service to the Guam Police Department and the Unified
46 Judiciary of Guam; and further extends a most sincere *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'åse'*
47 to his family in recognition of their support of his service to the people of Guam as a
