- 11 Simon A. Sanchez High School from 1999 to 2001; and, assistant principal
- 12 of Santa Rita's Southern High School from 2001 to 2002; and, assistant

- 1 principal of Yigo's Francisco B. Leon Guerrero Middle School from 2002
- through 2008; and, serving as the first principal of Guam's newest high
- 3 school Okkodo in the village of Dededo from 2008 through 2012; and,
- 4 WHEREAS, before beginning his legacy as an educator, Mr. Denusta
- 5 worked for the Guam Legislature for two (2) years (1983 and 1984) during
- 6 the 17<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature; and,
- WHEREAS, in 1981, Mr. Denusta graduated from John F. Kennedy
- 8 High School before going on to attain a Bachelor's in Secondary Education
- 9 Language Arts in 1987 and a Master's in Public Administration in 1993;

- WHEREAS, on September 18, 1963, Mr. Denusta was born to Castor
- and Veronica Denusta in Tamuning, Guam; and, was raised in a large family
- with six (6) siblings who lived in the central village of Piti and would later
- 14 move to the northern village of Dededo; and,
- WHEREAS, on February 16, 2001, Mr. Denusta married Mrs. Aileen
- 16 S. Denusta and together they are the proud parents of Delaina and Jeremy;

- WHEREAS, throughout the years, Mr. Denusta has taken part in
- 19 several civic and professional organizations including, the Latte Jaycees
- 20 (1986); the Japanese Language Institute (1987); as well as several Guam

- 1 Department of Education Committees such as "Onward to Excellence,"
- 2 "School Safety Crisis Team," "Joint Board Textbook Curriculum
- 3 Committee," "School Leaders Evaluation Committee," and "Service
- 4 Learning Committee;" he is also a member of the Association for

- and helping in the development of the School Leaders Evaluation instrument

- involved member of the school communities he served; as a teacher he
- served as advisor for numerous class councils, clubs and organizations to
- support students and their needs; and, even as an administrator, he remained
- actively involved with supervising or chaperoning student events; and,
