WHEREAS, Mr. Galo Lujan Perez has led a distinguished career working to 3

4 serve the people in the Northern Mariana Islands and Guam; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Perez began his career forty-eight (48) years ago June 2, 1964

as an Assistant Clerk I and worked his way up to Deputy Clerk III, with the Island

Court of Guam, now known as Superior Court of Guam; and 7

WHEREAS, Mr. Perez joined the U.S. District Court of Guam as the Chief 8

9 Deputy Clerk from November 3, 1969 to September 8, 1991; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 1991 at the invitation of Chief Judge Alex R. 10

Munson, Mr. Perez joined the U.S. District Court of the Northern Mariana Islands as

the Clerk of Court where he remained until his retirement on November 2, 2012; and

WHEREAS, during his tenure as the Clerk of Court Mr. Perez shepherded the 13

Court through the transition from the retirement of Chief Judge Munson in February 14

2010 through the first year of the tenure of Chief Judge Ramona V. Manglona; and

1	WHEREAS, Mr. Perez was instrumental in organizing the successful landmark		
2	visit to Saipan of the United States Supreme Court Sonia Sotomayor in January, 2012

4	WHEREAS, Mr. Perez is an active member of numerous community		
5	organizations such as a member of Knights of Columbus; one of the founders of the		
6	Latte Jaycees; Lifetime Senator of the Junior Chamber International; President of the		
7	Guam Youth Football League; President of the Guam Eagles Football League,		
8	Member of the Dededo Municipal Planning Council, and involved in the Dededo		
9	Men's Baseball League; and		
10	WHEREAS, because of his outstanding achievements, Mr. Perez was		
11	nominated in Who's Who in America, and		
12	WHEREAS, Mr. Perez, often time a father figure to many, is fondly known		
13	among all of his peers as being compassionate, very professional and humble, and		
14	always encouraging the staff to better themselves by attending off-island training; and		
15	WHEREAS, during his twenty-one (21) years working as the Clerk of Court		
16	for the U.S. District Court of the Northern Mariana Islands, his family remained on		
17	Guam and would travel to be with his family every weekend; and		
18	WHEREAS, Mr. Perez' life in Saipan for twenty-one (21) years would include		
19	flying every Monday morning to Saipan to begin his work week; he would often order		
20	a 2-choice plate for his dinner at D'Elegance to last for two meals; every Thursday		
21	evening he would pack his bag for his trip to Guam and every Friday after he gets off		
22	work, he would drive to the airport to catch his flight to Guam; and		
23	WHEREAS, Mr. Perez has been married to his beautiful bride of forty-six (46)		
24	years, Lourdes Benavente Quichocho; have three (3) children and ten (10)		
25	grandchildren; and		

1	WHEREAS, now that Mr. Perez is retired, he and his wife plan to spend their		
2	weekends in Saipan and weekdays on Guam; and		
3	RESOLVED; that the Committee on Rules of I Mina' Trentai Unu Na		
4	Liheslaturan Guahan does hereby on behalf of I Liheslaturan Guahan and the people		
5	of Guam does hereby recognize and commend Mr. Galo Lujan Perez on his retiremen
