WHEREAS, she was always innovative and finding ways to express her talents and skills to the community around her. Shortly after opening her restaurant, she started writing for her own column, Dining Diva, in the Pacific Daily News in 2007. Her column focuses on inspiring individuals to better appreciate life in general as it promotes perseverance, life understanding, goal-attainment, overcoming hardships. The Dining Diva column has been very successful as it gained attention to the community while also sharing her original recipes.
