Relative to commending and congratulating Mrs. Ana Fernandez Alave on the occasion of her retirement after twenty-seven (27) years of government service and to extend a warm *Un Dangkolo Na Si Yu'us Ma'ase* for her dedicated services in the Department of Defense.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF
I MINA'TRENTAI UNU NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Mrs. Ana Fernandez Alave was born on November 5, 1950 in Pangasinan, Philippines and was later married to Mr. Rogelio L. Alave for thirty four (34) years; and

WHEREAS, together, Mr. Rogelio L. Alave and Mrs. Ana Fernandez Alave have two children named Annaliza and Rochelle Alave Diaz, and two grandchildren whose names are Rylan John and Xavier Rai; and

WHEREAS, she currently holds the position of Financial Technician at the Commander, Joint Region Marinas Guam, since October 1, 2010: and

WHEREAS, she acquired her Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration and Management from the University of the East in Manila, Philippines on August of 1974; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on October of 1985 -1997 Mrs. Alave held a position as
2 Checkout Cashier in the Defense Commissary Agency at the Department of the
3 Navy; and

4 **WHEREAS**, since 1997, Mrs. Alave was assigned to the position of
5 Financial Technician and served in the same position until her retirement; and

6 **WHEREAS**, while she was in this position, provided sound oversight of
7 various Funds Control Authorization (FCA) documents totaling \$8 million,
8 balanced all accounts at fiscal year's end, assisted in developing fiscal closeout
9 guidance to assist all base agencies with budget execution, verified, audited, and
10 certified over 100 Request for Purchase forms ensuring delivery to Contracting in
11 less than 24 hours; and

12 **WHEREAS**, she also developed an automated control log for AF Form 9,
13 identified purchase orders, ensured funds were properly obligated to cover
14 payments, reconciled accounting database daily, validated and certified all
15 purchase orders and financial documents through the Automated Business Services
16 System; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Alave also played a key role in assisting Wing IG,
18 PACAF, and AMC resolve issues and complaints concerning unpaid bills and
19 allowed the Wing to operate with uninterrupted service; and

20 **WHEREAS**, she was also responsible for minimizing and reducing interest
21 penalty payments which helped increase wing funding flexibility, and maintained
22 unpaid invoices below 17%; and

23 **WHEREAS**, she was instrumental in her Accounting Liaison Office (ALO)
24 section in winning the Quality Assurance Award for two quarters, out beat other
25 sections in monthly performance indicators by 10% surpassing HQs standards, and
26 recognized by leadership as the backbone of the ALO; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in year 2009 Mrs. Ana F Alave won the Employee of the year
2 award with her following contribution to the 36 Airbase Wing Comptroller. She
3 managed \$8.1 Million base Government Purchase Card Program and maintain 119
4 accounts ensured timely and accurate monthly payments. Mrs. Alave expertly
5 supported \$33 Million Contingency operations ; \$1.8M in GPC loads to enable
6 Bomber, Fighter, and Tanker and AEF missions. She has committed \$6.5M Red
7 Horse funds to build up PRTC-NWF state of the art facility training. She corrected
8 over \$4.5k financial transactions with 99% accuracy: and

9 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Alave is an active member of the Pangasinan Community
10 Association and the San Carlos Association of Guam. She also participated in
11 other community services such as disaster assistance events, the American Red
12 Cross, University of Guam Scholarship Program; and

13 **WHEREAS**, she completed 6 CPE credit hours trained on Air Force and
14 Navy topics ready for successful Joint Region Migration in 2010.

15 **RESOLVED**, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam, commends
16 and congratulated Mrs. Ana Fernandez Alave on the occasion of her retirement
17 after her twenty-seven (27) years of government service and extend a warm *Un*
18 *Dangkolo Na Si Yu'os Ma'ase'* for her dedicated services in assisting the needs of
19 our island community; and be it further

20 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on
21 Rules certify, and the Secretary of the Legislature attest to, the adoption hereof,
