WHEREAS, Vinancio “Vince” C. Atalig was born in Rota, CNMI and moved to Guam in 1950 and now lives, with his loving wife Maria Quintanilla Atalig, adoringly called “Titta,” in Latte Heights Estates; and

WHEREAS, Vince has been blessed with four (4) beautiful daughters who all currently reside in Sacramento, California; and

WHEREAS, he has many years of experience in the areas of supervision and management including training sales & marketing; and

WHEREAS, Vince has worked for Moylan’s Insurance Underwriters, Nanbo Insurance Underwriters, Chase Manhattan Bank and Family Finance, and also opened up his insurance business “Atalig Insurance Agency” which has been in operation for seven (7) years; and

11 for his outstanding leadership and service, by former speaker and Dr. Franklin
12 Quitugua.; and
