8	WHEREAS, from 1989 to 1992, Cathy was a Social Worker for the US Air
9	Force Family Advocacy Program at Andersen Air Force Base; and
10	WHEREAS, from 1992 to 2000, Cathy held the position of Social Worker with
11	the Navy Fleet & Family Support Center; and
12	WHEREAS, from 2000 to 2002, Cathy was a Family Life Consultant with the
13	Family Support Center at Andersen Air Force Base; and
14	WHEREAS, from 2002 to present, Cathy has been Team Leader and Clinical
15	Social Worker at the Guam Vet Center, Readjustment Counseling Service,
16	Department of Veterans Affairs, where she has worked with combat veterans and
17	families coping with posttraumatic stress disorder and associated issues; and
18	WHEREAS, during her tenure at the Guam Vet Center, Cathy has spearheaded
19	the organization of the annual Guam Veterans' Creative Arts Showcase and the annual
