- 9 of Science in Nursing degree in 2001; and
- 10 WHEREAS, she currently supervises the district nurses and the staff in the
- medical clinic in Central Public Health in Mangilao; and
- WHEREAS, Ms. Manibusan was recently honored by the American
- 13 Academy of Nurse Practitioners by being presented with the 2012 State Award for
- 14 Nurse Practitioner Excellence at their 27th Annual Conference in Orlando, Florida
- that was held in June 2012. The award is given annually to a dedicated nurse
- practitioner in each state who demonstrates excellence in their area of practice; and
