1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose Salucnamnam San Nicolas was born on
4 December 15, 1945; and is the son of Juan Cruz and Ana Salucnamnam San Nicolas
5 from the beautiful village of *Agat*; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose Salucnamnam San Nicolas, also known as
2 “*Jose’n Pineda*” to close family and friends, was inspired by his family and friends
3 to pursue a prayer leadership role; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas started his *techa* career at the
5 tender age of twelve (12), when he traveled and said rosaries throughout the island, to
6 include places such as California, Hawaii, Washington and Germany; and

7 **WHEREAS**, during the early 1970s, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas
8 decided to run for the position of Assistant Commissioner, and he was easily elected
9 because of his popularity with the youth; and

10 **WHEREAS**, in 1973, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas decided to run for
11 the higher position of Commissioner, and he was once again easily elected; and

12 **WHEREAS**, at the age of twenty-five (25) years old, the late Honorable Jose
13 San Nicolas was one of the youngest individuals ever elected to public service on
14 Guam; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas kept the youth of *Agat* out of
16 trouble by taking them off the streets and keeping them productive; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas was not only active with the
18 youth in *Agat*, but he was also very active with the *man’amko*; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas brought his church life and
20 his government duties together because he knew that spirituality and government were
21 very much a part of our *Chamorro* culture; and

22 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure in office, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas
23 served the people of *Agat* and the people of Guam in a most honorable and exemplary
24 manner, always ensuring that the health, safety and general well-being of the residents
25 of *Agat* were attended to; and

1 **WHEREAS**, in 1974, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas married the
2 beautiful Lourdes Reyes Diaz; and together they had two (2) beautiful children:
3 Dwayne and Charmaine; and

4 **WHEREAS**, in December 1979, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas lost his
5 wife, and he had to raise his two (2) children on his own; and

6 **WHEREAS**, during this time, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas left public
7 service as an elected official, but he continued to serve the community as a *techa*; and
8 he also held several different government posts; and

9 **WHEREAS**, in the mid 1990s, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas ended his
10 public service after serving as a Special Assistant to former Governor Carl T.C.
11 Gutierrez with the Community Outreach Program; and

12 **WHEREAS**, throughout the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas' life, his humor,
13 vitality and versatility allowed him to work with both Republicans and Democrats
14 alike; and


15 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Jose San Nicolas' family and friends would
16 best describe him as, "getting things done and he did it with laughter"; now therefore,

23 passing; and be it further


24 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules

- 2 Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*.


