**Relative to recognizing and commending the Honorable Mana Silva Taijeron for her invaluable service to the people of Guam as a Member of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.**

1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3           **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Mana Silva Taijeron is a daughter of Guam and a  
4 lifelong resident, and she has served our island community in various capacities; and

5           **WHEREAS**, at an early age, the Honorable Mana Silva Taijeron made her  
6 foray into the field of journalism and worked for various island news organizations for

1 approximately seventeen (17) years, in which she covered a wide range of topics,  
2 particularly issues that focused on public safety; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the Honorable Mana Silva Taijeron was a mainstay as a news  
4 reporter of several island radio stations' news programs; and she had served as the  
5 anchorwoman during the initial evening news broadcasts of the Pacific News Center;  
6 and

7 **WHEREAS**, in 2010, the Honorable Mana Silva Taijeron was elected by the  
8 people of Guam to serve as a Member of *I Mina'Trentai Unu Na Liheslaturan*  
9 *Guåhan* (the 31<sup>st</sup> Guam Legislature); and

10 **WHEREAS**, in her role as a public servant, Senator Silva Taijeron was a  
11 steadfast supporter of Guam's public safety agencies, working with the Office of *I*  
12 *Maga'lahaen Guåhan* to pay past due overtime payments to Officers of the Department  
13 of Corrections and the Guam Police Department; and

14 **WHEREAS**, as a Member of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, Senator Mana Silva  
15 Taijeron championed efforts to preserve the *Chamorro* language and culture by  
16 authoring a public law mandating the expansion of the *Chamorro* language and  
17 culture curriculum within the Department of Education. Additionally, Senator Mana  
18 Silva Taijeron worked to help grow Guam's economy by sponsoring a law which  
19 extended the qualifying certificate eligibility to foreign and local investors interested  
20 in operating "green technology" businesses on Guam; now therefore, be it

21 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*  
22 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people  
23 of Guam, recognize and commend the Honorable Mana Silva Taijeron for her service  
24 to the people of Guam as a Member of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*; and be it further

25 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules  
26 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of

- 1 the same be thereafter transmitted to the Honorable Mana Silva Taijeron; and to the
- 2 Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
