1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Mayor Vicente “Ben” I. Aguon was born on
4 July 6, 1939; and he was called to his eternal reward on Monday, January 21, 2013, at
5 the age of seventy-three (73); and

1 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Mayor Vicente “Ben” I. Aguon is the son of
2 †Jose Manglona Aguon and Emperatriz Cruz Ignacio Aguon; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Mayor Vicente “Ben” I. Aguon married Pacita
4 Baza Aguon, and they were blessed with seven (7) children; and

5 **WHEREAS**, in 2000, the late Honorable Mayor Vicente “Ben” I. Aguon was
6 elected as Mayor of the municipality of *Chalan Pago-Ordot*; and he proudly served
7 the people of *Chalan Pago-Ordot* from January 2001 to January 2005; and

8 **WHEREAS**, prior to serving the people of *Chalan Pago-Ordot* as Mayor, the
9 late Honorable Ben Aguon had served for fifteen (15) years with the Department of
10 Public Works (DPW), where he worked as an Electrical and Refrigeration Technician,
11 from 1965 to 1972; as a Construction Inspector III, from 1972 to 1973; as a
12 Construction Inspector Supervisor, from 1973 to 1980; and then finished his career
13 with DPW as a Construction Project Manager and Acting Engineer II; and

14 **WHEREAS**, after leaving the Department of Public Works, the late Mayor Ben
15 Aguon worked as a Legislative Consultant with the 18th and 19th Guam Legislatures,
16 under the Committee on Rules; and

17 **WHEREAS**, following his employment with the Guam Legislature, the late
18 Mayor Ben Aguon worked as a Manager of the *Tumon* Village Complex; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Mayor Ben Aguon was an active community
20 member, serving as a member of the Liturgical Group and the Parish Council of Our
21 Lady of Peace and Safe Journey Catholic Church in *Chalan Pago*; he had served as
22 the Assistant State Commissioner for the Guam Babe Ruth Baseball; and also served
23 as a member of the *Chalan Pago-Ordot* Municipal Planning Council; and

24 **WHEREAS**, during his tenure in office, the late Mayor Aguon served the
25 people of *Chalan Pago-Ordot* in a most honorable and exemplary manner, ensuring

1 that the health, safety and general well-being of the residents of *Chalan Pago-Ordot*
2 were attended to; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the late Honorable Vicente I. Aguon was a man of honor and
4 compassion whose passing will leave a void that will be felt for many years to come,
5 in both the family he loved and the island he so proudly served; now therefore, be it

6 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
7 *Lihsaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihsaturan Guåhan* and the people
8 of Guam, recognize and memorialize the late Honorable Vicente "Ben" I. Aguon,
9 former Mayor of *Chalan Pago-Ordot*, for his many achievements and
10 accomplishments; and does further extend sincere condolences to his family on his
11 passing; and be it further

12 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
13 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
14 the same be thereafter transmitted to the family of the late Honorable Vicente "Ben" I.
15 Aguon; to the Mayors' Council of Guam; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I*
