1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS,** the Association of Government Accountants (AGA) is a national
4 association with the vision to serve as the premier association in advancing
5 government accountability by supporting the careers and professional development of
6 government finance professionals working in federal, state and local governments, as

1 well as the private sector and academia. Founded in 1950, AGA has a long history of
2 being the thought leader for the government accountability profession. Through
3 education, research, publications, certification and conferences, AGA reaches
4 thousands of professionals and provides more than one hundred thousand (100,000)
5 continuing professional education (CPE) hours annually; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the AGA Guam Chapter was established in 1970, and has since
7 been an active organization in our community. Dr. Doreen Crisostomo, a University
8 of Guam (UOG) Accounting Professor, has served as part of the AGA for many years.
9 She has held various positions, including the Certified Government Financial Manager
10 (CGFM) Director for the Guam Chapter; the CGFM Coordinator for the Pacific Rim;
11 the Regional Vice President for the Pacific Rim; and, currently, she is the President-
12 elect for the Guam Chapter, and the Immediate Past Regional Vice President for the
13 Pacific Rim; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Crisostomo received national recognition for Chapter CGFM
15 Awards for program years 2009 and 2010; the Regional Coordinator for Certification
16 Award in program year 2011; and the Platinum Regional Vice President Award in
17 program year 2012; and

18 **WHEREAS**, in 2012, the AGA National kicked-off their Sixth (6th) Annual
19 Government Finance Case Challenge, inviting the best undergraduate
20 accounting/financial management/business students in the country to compete.
21 Student teams were to collaboratively analyze and offer a written response to a case
22 centered on how a U.S. city government creates a citizen-centric report. All the
23 members of the two (2) highest-scoring teams received a scholarship to attend the
24 AGA's National Leadership Conference; and

25 **WHEREAS**, Dr. Crisostomo formed a four (4)-member student team from her
26 UOG Fall 2012 BA401 "Government Accounting" class. Under her guidance as their

1 Faculty Advisor, the team of Ms. Cindelle Maye O. Sazon, Ms. Angeline Corpus
2 Nieto, Mr. Steven Patrick Delgado and Mr. Russell Jon Miranda Bala-an entered the
3 AGA National's competition to prepare a citizen-centric report for Loudoun County
4 Public Schools, Virginia; to include a paper that summarizes the criteria and the
5 justification the team used to decide what information to include and exclude in the
6 performance report; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the UOG team of Sazon, Nieto, Delgado and Bala-an,
8 successfully placed as one (1) of the top two (2) finalist teams, along with North
9 Carolina State University; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the members of the UOG team of Sazon, Nieto, Delgado and
11 Bala-an have accepted their scholarship awards to attend the AGA National
12 Leadership Conference in Washington, D.C., on February 12-13, 2013, where they
13 will present their finalized solutions before a panel of federal, state and local
14 government leaders, corporate partners, and chief financial officers. The AGA assures
15 that this experience promises to challenge students' moral reasoning, raise their
16 awareness of the importance of government accountability, and open doors to a future
17 career in government; now therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na*
19 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
20 of Guam, recognize and commend Dr. Doreen T. Crisostomo, Ph.D., University of

22 Steven Patrick Delgado and Russell Jon Miranda Bala-an for their accomplishments in

8 University of Guam; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahañ Guåhan*.


