3 Jason Keith, Jimmy John, Jared Thomas and Jacob Vance; and are also blessed with
4 seventeen (17) grandchildren; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Jenbel V. Manibusan started her government of Guam career
6 on November 26, 1980, working at the Judiciary of Guam as an Assistant Clerk I; and

7 **WHEREAS**, on January 1, 1982, Mrs. Jenbel V. Manibusan was appointed to
8 serve as a Word Processing Technician; and she was eventually promoted to the
9 position of Word Processing Technician II, on October 6, 1982; and

10 **WHEREAS**, on December 22, 1986, Mrs. Jenbel V. Manibusan was promoted
11 to Deputy Clerk III; and she subsequently rose to the Deputy Clerk IV position on
12 December 3, 1989; and

15 as the Traffic Violations Bureau Clerk, in an acting capacity, on October 1, 2003; and

17 once again, and was permanently appointed to the Traffic Violations Bureau Clerk
