1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, on March 8, 1980, President Jimmy Carter issued a Presidential**
4 **Proclamation declaring the week of March 8th as the first “National Women’s History**

1 Week,” honoring and recognizing women for their contributions throughout American
2 history, and their pivotal cultural, social, and economic role in our society. This effort
3 resulted in a national movement to recognize the contributions of women nationally
4 and internationally, leading to the proclamation of the month of March as “National
5 Women’s History Month”; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the United States Congress has recognized that women of every
7 race, class, and ethnic background have served as leaders in the forefront of every
8 major progressive social change movement, including securing the rights of suffrage
9 and equal opportunity for women, the abolitionist movement, the emancipation
10 movement, the industrial labor movement, the civil rights movement, and other
11 movements seeking to create a more fair and just society for all; and

12 **WHEREAS**, the United States Congress has recognized that despite these
13 contributions that have tremendously shaped the identity of our nation, the role of
14 women in history has been consistently overlooked and undervalued, for which
15 purpose a theme has thus been developed each year to address the ways women
16 continue to succeed in spite of such struggles; and

17 **WHEREAS**, to celebrate the 2013 “National Women’s History Month,” the
18 Guam Vet Center, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs, Unique Pacific
19 Resources, WestCare Pacific Islands, and the Bureau of Women’s Affairs-Guam
20 Department of Labor/Agency for Human Resources Development are sponsoring the
21 Seventh (7th) Annual Women Veterans Conference, with this year’s theme being “She
22 Served, She Deserves: Enhancing Accessibility to Services,” with the primary goal of
23 recognizing women veterans for the contributions they have made through their
24 military service, and within their communities; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Conference also seeks to provide current information
2 regarding the services and benefits offered by the U.S. Department of Veterans
3 Affairs, and encourages female veterans to utilize such existing services; and seeks to
4 promote a greater understanding of women’s issues by obtaining input from women
5 veterans, while concurrently building resilience against continued struggles where
6 they may exist through better promulgation of the unique and significant roles women
7 have within our community; now therefore, be it

8 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’Trentai Dos Na*
9 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
10 of Guam, recognize and commend women for their contributions to our island
11 community on the celebration of the month of March 2013 as “National Women’s
12 History Month,” and encourage island residents to observe this special month by
13 giving respect, recognition and admiration to all women for their historic contributions
14 to the growth and strength of our island; and does further commend and congratulate
15 the organizers and sponsors of the Seventh (7th) Annual Women Veterans Conference
16 for their foresight and continued commitment to recognizing women, and women
17 veterans in particular, for the contributions they have made to our island, our region,
18 our nation, and the world; and be it further

19 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
20 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
21 the same be thereafter transmitted to the Guam Vet Center; to the U.S. Department of
22 Veterans Affairs; to the Bureau of Women’s Affairs-Guam Department of
23 Labor/Agency for Human Resources Development; to Unique Pacific Resources; to
24 WestCare Pacific Islands; to the Honorable Madeleine Z. Bordallo, Guam’s Delegate

1 to the United States Congress; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahren*
2 *Guåhan*.


