3           **WHEREAS**, on the evening of February 12, 2013, a terrible tragedy took  
4 place in *Tumon*, the heart of Guam's tourism district; and

5           **WHEREAS**, the lives of many families were affected by the acts of a lone  
6 criminal; and

1           **WHEREAS**, a majority of the persons affected, 13 of the 14 victims, were  
2 Japanese nationals; and

3           **WHEREAS**, the island community mourns with the victims and families of  
4 those affected; now therefore, be it

5           **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'Trentai Dos Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does  
6 hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, express its humble and sincere  
7 condolences, and deepest regret and wishes of hope, on a quick recovery to all the  
8 victims and their families, and to the people of Japan for the loss of life and  
9 physical and emotional suffering resulting from a senseless and isolated criminal  
10 act in Guam's tourism capital; and be it further

11           **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest  
12 to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the same be thereafter transmitted to the  
13 Honorable Hisatsugu Shimizu, Guam Consul General of Japan; to the Honorable  
14 Shinzo Abe, Prime Minister of Japan; to His Majesty Akihito, Emperor of Japan;  
15 to the Honorable Madeleine Z. Bordallo, Guam Delegate of the United States  
16 Congress; and to the Honorable Edward J.B. Calvo, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*.
