Student teams were to collaboratively analyze and offer a written response to a case centered on how a U.S. city government creates a CCR; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Doreen Crisostomo, UOG Accounting Professor, formed a four (4) member student team from her Fall 2012 BA401 "Government Accounting" class, of which Mr. Russell Jon Miranda Bala-an was a member. Under the guidance of Dr. Crisostomo, the team of Bala-an, Mr. Steven Patrick Delgado, Ms. Cindelle Mayo Sazon and Ms. Angeline Corpuz Nieto entered the AGA National's competition to prepare a Citizen-Centric Report for the Loudoun County Public Schools, Virginia; to include a paper that summarizes the criteria and the justification the team used to decide what information to include and exclude in the performance report; and
