1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA 'TRENTAI DOS NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, the Association of Government Accountants (AGA) is a
4 professional organization with a network of 15,000 members in over 100 chapters
5 across the United States, and around the world, representing state, federal, local
6 government, and private accountability professionals; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the AGA Guam Chapter has 195 members who work to
2 uphold AGA’s mission of *Advancing Government Accountability*, as it continues
3 its broad educational efforts with an emphasis on high standards of conduct, honor
4 and character in its *Code of Ethics*, and who are making significant advances both
5 in professional ability and in service to the residents of Guam by mastering
6 increasingly technical and complex requirements; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the Certified Government Financial Manager (CGFM)
8 Program of AGA provides a means of demonstrating professionalism and
9 competency by requiring CGFM candidates, 24 of which are from the AGA Guam
10 Chapter, to have appropriate education and professional experience, to abide by
11 AGA’s *Code of Ethics*, and to pass 3 examinations requiring expertise in
12 governmental environment, governmental financial management and control, and
13 governmental accounting, financial reporting and budgeting; and requires each
14 CGFM member to maintain certification by completing at least 80 hours of
15 continuing professional education in government financial management topics, or
16 related technical subjects, every 2 years; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the AGA CGFM Guam team is led by Mr. Jose Guevara III,
18 CGFM, who is the CGFM Director for the AGA Guam Chapter, and the
19 Certification Regional Coordinator for the AGA-Pacific Rim; Ms. Frances Danieli,
20 CGFM, who is the CGFM Co-chairperson for the AGA Guam Chapter; the AGA
21 Guam Chapter President, Jason V. Katigbak, MBA, CPA, CIA, CFE, CGMA; and
22 AGA Regional Vice President-Past, Pacific Rim, Doreen T. Crisostomo, CGFM,
23 Ph.D.; and


24 **WHEREAS**, these dedicated individuals lead a passionate group of people
25 in the government financial management profession, which is characterized by its
26 efforts to achieve common objectives and by its observance of certain fundamental
27 principles; these AGA CGFM members must adhere to ethical requirements to

1 ensure the highest quality of performance and to maintain public confidence in the
2 profession; now therefore, be it


3 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina Trentai Dos Na*
4 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the
5 people of Guam, recognize and commend Guam’s Certified Government Financial
6 Managers (CGFM) of the Association of Government Accountants Guam Chapter
7 on the observance of March 2013 as “CGFM Month”; and be it further

15 Calvo, *I Maga’lahen Guåhan*.


